

SEPTEMBER 2017 DACA ANNOUNCEMENT

What happened?

- Attorney General Jeff Sessions announced that the administration will end Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA).
- President Trump has called on Congress to enact legislation to replace the DACA before the program fully ends on March 5, 2018.

What does this announcement mean for me?

I have DACA



- **Your DACA is valid until its expiration date!**
- If your DACA permit expires before March 5, 2018 you **MUST** apply for renewal before October 5, 2017
- The Department of Homeland Security will **NOT** grant Advance Parole to travel abroad

I do not have DACA



New applications for DACA will **NOT** be accepted after Sept. 5, 2017
