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Community Navigator Certification Agreement

Community Navigators are community members who receive specialized training to provide quality immigration services for their communities in an empowering and effective way. The Community Navigator Program functions as a community-based legal service and protection strategy that provides invaluable outreach, education, document preparation, screening and naturalization assistance to immigrant communities.

Through the PICC Community Navigator Certification, you will be trained to:

- Conduct public education information sessions
- Lead workshops on Know Your Rights and Deportation Defense Preparation
- Work with families to develop Deportation Defense Packets and gather documents
- Organize legal workshops and legal clinics to provide pre-screening through community workshops (with attorneys and/or fully accredited reps present)
- Participate in and implement Rapid Response Plans

Steps to PICC Certification:

- Complete Community Navigator Certification Agreement
- Attend entire Community Navigator Core Curriculum (Modules 1-6)
- Complete and submit follow-up review worksheets for each Module
- Update Training Log after attending each Module and give completed log to PICC
- Commit to volunteering at or organizing a minimum of three community information sessions or legal clinics within six months of completing Core Curriculum
- Agree to follow PICC Community Navigator Principles:
 - Providing quality service
 - Collaborating with PICC members and partners to provide services
 - Sharing information and expertise with other PICC members
 - Engaging in a model that centers the leadership and participation of immigrant communities
 - Reaching PA's diverse immigrant communities (geographic and country of origin)
